Purpose of Chapter

- Represent pensioners' issues (e.g. Health & Dental Benefits, and Pension Security).
- Keep pensioners informed on matters important to them.
- Co-ordinate with other pensioner groups on broader pensioner issues (strength in numbers) e.g. Congress of Union Retirees of Canada (CURC) (www.unionretiree.ca) and Canadian Federation of Pensioners (CFP) (www.pensioners.ca).

Who Can Join

If you are retired as a Society-represented employee or as their spouse are receiving survivor benefits you can become a Full Member.

If you were a Society-represented employee but left in a Management Function or other management position, you can become an Associate Member.

If you are a Society member on a bridge to retirement, or on LTD (fee waived during the bridge or deferment period pending retirement) or who has left employment but has a "deferred pension", you may also apply to become a Chapter Member.

Highlights of What Pensioners' Chapter is Accomplishing

- Representing pensioners' interests at Society Council and Society Board.
- Input into Society bargaining committees regarding future changes affecting health benefits and pension security.
- Reaffirmed that The Society is there to protect pensioners' rights by having pensioner problems treated the same as other member's concerns.
